He is a volunteer Clinical Assistant Professor at the University of Cincinnati College of Medicine, Department of Ophthalmology, and was voted teacher of the year by his residents in 2011. Dr. Khatana uses the latest cataract surgical technology, including the use of toric and multifocal intraocular lenses and specializes in the management of various complicated and advanced forms of glaucoma, as well as all the newer minimally invasive glaucoma surgeries.
