He is both a Senior Achievement Award recipient from the American Academy of Ophthalmology and a Senior Honor Award from American Society of Retinal Specialists.

He has received multiple Cleveland Clinic Innovations Awards for his work in novel imaging analysis. He has co-authored over 140 publications in peer-reviewed journals and has delivered over 200 lectures at national and international conferences. His current interest include the use of novel imaging in uveitis and retinal diseases, the development imaging outcome measures in uveitis and intraoperative imaging in vireo-retinal surgery.

Dr. MacIntosh also is the director of the Ophthalmology Residency Training Program, and he has a special interest in education and curriculum development. He is an associate professor of Ophthalmology at the University of Illinois College of Medicine.

He holds a faculty position in the Department of Ophthalmology and Vision Sciences, University of Toronto, and is on staff at Credit Valley Hospital, Trillium Health Partners.

Dr. Teichman has a keen interest in research, currently focusing on medical and surgical treatments of corneal disease, and is a member of the elite few performing some of the most intricate corneal surgeries in Canada. He has authored many publications and has given numerous presentations at national and international conferences.
